

7. Guidelines to follow during the 1 on 1 Korean Class

- 1) 1 on 1 Korean class **conducts only the following time** and before starting the class you have to set the class schedule with your instructor.
 - **weekday from 9 am to 1 pm**
 - **weekday from 2 pm to 6 pm**
- 2) If you want to **cancel or change the time of the class, you have to contact your teacher 24 hours before each class.** After that you are marked as absent.
- 3) A make-up class **only offers** only the following two situations.
 - ① **Changing your class schedule 24 hours before the class**
 - ② **Changing your class schedule due to the unavoidable circumstances occurred by the instructor**

※ **The make-up class only offers during the weekday from 9 am to 1 pm or from 2 pm to 6 pm.**
- 4) The 1 on 1 Korean class is a 50-minute class and it is scheduled to be held for 2 hours every week. If the instructor agrees, 2 hours in a row are also available.
- 5) If you do **NOT** attend the class **until 10 minutes after the start of class** without prior notice, **you will be marked as absent.**
